MALAYSIA - FIRST ASIAN COUNTRY TO HOST 3rd GLOBAL WOMEN DELIVER CONFERENCE 2013

 Global experts to meet in Malaysia to address and tackle issues on maternal and reproductive health of women in 3rd Global Women Deliver Conference 2013

Kuala Lumpur, **29 April 2013** – Strongly supported by the Malaysia Convention & Exhibition Bureau (MyCEB), the 3rd Global Women Deliver Conference 2013 (WD 2013) is set to gather global experts this year from May 28-30. The conference attended by various parties including healthcare professionals, policymakers, government leader and many more aims to address women deliver issues and ensure that investments in girls and women remain a global priority to authorities around the world.

Organised by the Women Deliver headquartered in New York, United States of America, Malaysia is the first Asian country to be given the honour to host this landmark conference. It is expected to attract 5,000 delegates and generate an estimated RM72.5 million in economic impact. The groundbreaking conference which was launched in 2007 was previously held in London and Washington.

WD 2013 will focus on a broad range of critical issues related to women's health and mortality. The first day of the conference will be emphasizing on Women Deliver's keynote theme – "Women". The second day will be

addressing the unmet need for family planning and the final day will concentrate on the post 2015 development framework. The overall themes of the conference highlight and stress the importance of investing in women's health, education, empowerment and rights.

WD 2013 looks forward to explore how global community can address and decrease the unmet need for modern contraception through the developed Millennium Development Programme 5 (MDG 5). Key influential speakers will be features at the conference Melinda Gates of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation; HRH Crown Princess Mette Marit of Norway, Zainah Anwar of Global Movement for Equality and Justice in the Muslim Family, Malaysia and many more. A powerful forum to ensure the continuous advocacy for girls and women in the future will also be organised during the conference as well as a virtual media room which will add to its attraction.

"WD 2013 is one of the many high profile health and medical conferences that Malaysia will be hosting this year. It is such an honour for MyCEB to be able to support these impactful events that will ultimately change the quality of life for all mankind for the better. This also reflects positively on Malaysia's strong track record in hosting global conferences in line with the Bureau's mission under the Economic Transformation Programme (ETP), which is to grow business tourism arrivals of the country," commented Zulkefli Hj Sharif, CEO of MyCEB.
