Launched in 2012, the Kesatria 1Malaysia Programme consists of industry leaders and presidents or past presidents of national associations who are tasked with attracting global meetings and conferences to Malaysia. Going by the belief of promoting success, stimulating growth, and generating wealth for the industry and the nation, the programme aims to provide Kesatria a platform to discover new, dynamic and productive opportunities to develop in their respective fields.

Through the Kesatria 1Malaysia Programme, MyCEB has generated 71 business events leads, attracting an estimated 124,958 delegate and contributing an estimated RM 1.4 billion in economic impact to the country. Of these, 39% of bids were won and supported with 28 events secured, amounting to approximately 39,000 delegates and RM 371 million in economic impact.

Zulkefli Haji Sharif, Chief Executive Officer of MyCEB, highlighted the central role played by Kesatria in attracting business events and expressed confidence that the Kesatria would continue to help raise the country's profile globally.

"We celebrate the contributions of our distinguished Kesatria in securing international association conferences. In November 2011, MyCEB unveiled its business events tagline, 'Malaysia – Asia's Business Events Hub' which encompasses its aim to communicate Malaysia's proposition as a gateway to Asia for meetings – where many of Asia's diverse cultures, languages and lifestyles are represented and have merged through a long history of trade and meetings. Last year, MyCEB (Business Events Division) supported 42 associations and 91 corporate incentive groups representing 81,350 delegates to organize their events in Malaysia. The country has also played host to 106 meetings and conventions, 18 exhibitions and 109 corporate incentive groups.
